WHY YOU SHOULD STUDY IN A REGIONAL AREA?

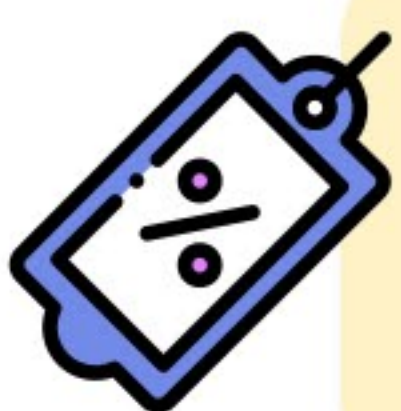
The regional area in Australia is an option taken by many international students.

There are a number of higher education providers located in regional and country Australia, which give you the opportunity to explore 'the real Australia' outside the big capital cities. There are some great reasons why you should think about studying in regional Australia: regional institutions offer a great relaxing lifestyle, a more personalized university experience, beautiful natural scenery and additional opportunities for migration.



1. LIFESTYLE

REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION



Your valid passport



Satisfactory completion of Year 10 or overseas equivalent



Academic Proof (Certified and Translated) - back home and onshore



Transcripts (Certified and Translated)



English Proof - each course require certain score in ACADEMIC IELTS, but the minimum normally is 5.0.



***For Master courses, you need above requirements, plus:**



Or have complete certain studies onshore (VET or similar), plus have some Job Experience comproved in the field of the studies you are applying.



Or have a Bachelor Degree (onshore or overseas)

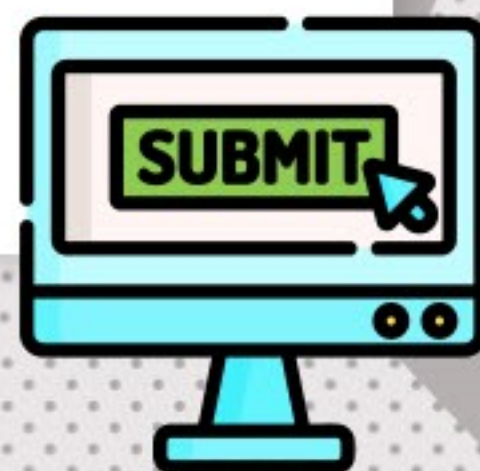

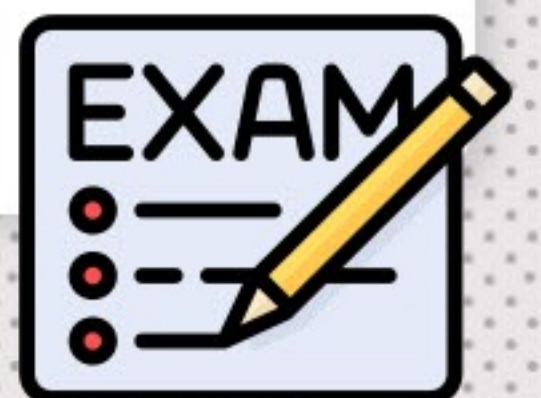

PATHWAYS INTO AUSTRALIA

Australia has different visas leading to permanent residency available for migrants. These visas are often referred to as skilled-migration visas (General Skilled Migration). Here are some of the well-known visas:

What are the courses that will lead to permanent residency (PR) in Australia?

With more than 170 occupations on the Combined Skilled Lists, there are different courses that you can take to gain PR in Australia. Following are the popular courses that lead to a GSM pathway in Australia.



SOCIAL WORK COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Considered one of the fastest growing occupations in Australia, social work courses attract international students who want to work closely with people afflicted with personal or social issues.



Social workers can apply for various permanent residency visas (189, 190, 489 visas and more). For the 2018 – 2019 period, the occupation ceiling is 2,125.



A Bachelor or Master of Social Work will be needed to apply.



NURSING COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Australia's ever-growing population depends on its highly skilled medical staff in providing healthcare. Consistently being included in the skills lists, nursing is one of the desired courses in the medical field.



Nursing graduates will be able to apply for various permanent residency visas (189, 190, 489, & more). Overseas registered nurses can take bridging courses to get registered.



Registration is required to be eligible.



INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

The demand for Information and Communication Technology (ICT) graduates is consistently in the rise to cope with the growing need of the industries. Specialising in hardware, software, network, security and web development courses.



ICT occupations in the skills list are ICT Business & Systems Analyst, Analyst Programmer, Developer Programmer, Software Engineer, Computer Network and Systems Engineer, and more.



ICT graduates might be required to apply for a Professional Year program to be eligible for a skilled visa.



ENGINEERING COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Australia is one of the frontrunners in the field of engineering. International students are drawn to the country to learn and kick-start their careers in various specialisation.



ACCOUNTING COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Amongst the top course choices for international students, accounting course receives thousands of students aspiring to become successful accountants or auditors. investments, research and development.



EDUCATION AND TEACHING COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Pursuing a career in the field of education holds power in making differences by inspiring students' curious minds.

Occupations needed in Australia are Chemical Engineer, Materials Engineer, Civil Engineer, Geotechnical Engineer, Electrical Engineer, Electronics Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, Aeronautical Engineer, Agricultural Engineer, Environmental Engineer, and Industrial Engineer.

In the Medium and Long-term Strategic Skills List (MLTSSL) and the combined list of eligible skilled occupations are Accountant (General), Management Accountant, Taxation Accountant, External Auditor, Corporate Treasurer.

The teaching profession in the skills lists are Early Childhood (Pre-Primary School) Teacher; Primary School Teacher; Secondary School Teacher; Special Needs Teacher; University Lecturer; Vocational Education Teacher; and Teacher of English to Speakers of Other Languages.



AUTOMOTIVE COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

There are plenty of automotive courses available for international students. The most popular among international students are Light Vehicle Mechanical Technology and Automotive Mechanical Diagnosis.

Taking these courses can lead to a career as a light vehicle mechanical technician, automotive technician, or automotive technical adviser. Graduates also gain hands-on experience through placements.



COOKERY & HOSPITALITY COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Courses under the Cookery and Hospitality field not only promise an exciting career but also hold potential in obtaining permanent residency status.

Cookery and Hospitality jobs on the list are Chef; Cafe or Restaurant Manager; Hotel or Motel Manager; Licensed Club Manager; Bed and Breakfast Operator; Accommodation and Hospitality Managers; and more.



BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION COURSE PATHWAY TO PR

Trade courses like carpentry, joinery, and bricklaying are now available to international students. International students can now pursue a career as a carpenter, joiner, and bricklayer.

These occupations have a high occupation ceiling.
